

Bear Country Outfitters - Hunter Checklist

To help you plan we've made a checklist for you!

- If you are rifle hunting you must have a white, red, or blaze orange jacket or vest and an orange or red hat (white or orange camouflage hat is not acceptable), this is required by law
- Hunting clothes (we suggest layered clothing to accommodate the changing weather – from nice spring/fall and summer-like days to very cool evenings and rain)
- Rain gear, hunting or waterproof boots, warm hat, gloves
- Bug jacket, mosquito hat/face net (not required, but suggested)
- ThermaCell and refills (**these are indispensable!**) and bug spray
- Protective case for weapon – soft case preferred for travel to/from stands
- Seat cushion (for in tree stand)
- Tree stand safety harness
- Gear/tree hooks and hoist rope
- **Head lamp** / flashlight
- Any cover scent or lure you like to use (personal preference, not required)
- Camera (or phone)
- Range finder and binoculars (personal preference, not required)
- A regular watch - the time on Apple watches, etc. and cell phones often switch time zones back & forth (CST in SK, CDT in MB – 1 hour time difference) if not set correctly
- Personal care products including towels
- Sleeping bag, bed sheet & pillow (to accommodate varying temperatures)
- Slip-on or light shoes to wear around camp, for easy removal when in and out of cabins (Crocs are popular)
- Favorite camp/campfire chair which could also be used in ground blind (we do have chairs available)
- All meals are provided but feel free to bring any snacks you like
- Favorite spirits/mix & bottled water
- Fishing equipment for pike and walleye if you plan to fish
- Cooler to transport trophy
- Meat cutting/deboning tools and packaging supplies if you plan to keep any meat
